SCOTTISH LEARNING FESTIVAL

Last week 6 children from P7 along with Valerie Thomson from the school and Peter Diamond, Head of Schools attended the Scottish Learning Festival in Glasgow showcasing the Scrapstore Playpod development at Glaitness. Morag Miller was already at the Scottish Learning Festival as part of the local authority presentations and met the children there to promote the work we have been doing on this. The children were playing with scrap and answering questions from the audience about this. Valerie and Morag spoke about the project as well and the difference it had made to the playground. The children did really well showcasing the project and met Mike Russell, the Education Minister and Bill Maxwell, Chief Executive of Education Scotland. A highlight of the trip was Pizza Hut on the Wednesday night though! This is set to develop further with inclusion in 'The Journey to Excellence' website run by Education Scotland for promoting examples of innovative practice in schools across Scotland.
