2. Minutes of last meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minutes were proposed by Sheena Leask and seconded by Bridget Moodie 	
3. Matters arising from Minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Alice had enquired who would cover when the school patrols officers were off but the police considered this a low risk to cover, and there are eight lollipop staff to cover. Possibility of speed bumps by the crossing at the school were looked into but this was not possible as the road is a main transport route. 	
4. Fundraising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There was no fundraising planned for next term apart from the Spring Fair. 	
5. Finance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The treasurer was not in attendance, so there was no report. 	
6. Spring Fair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> It was decided that there would be a 20p admission charge at the gate. Each parent representative was assigned a stall and hoped to get others to help them. Helpers were to arrive just after 10am to set up stalls. 	
7. Parental Involvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An update was given on the recent workshop for Parent Councils, this was attended by Lynn Rendall who found it interesting to see what other Parent Councils had achieved in their first year. Orkney Islands Council Are to release a Parent Council newsletter later in the year.
